## GRASS SEEDING AND COVER CROPS

- Native Grass – 2,198
- Tame Grass – 1,467
- Cover Crops – 2,154



## INFRASTRUCTURE – 29,484 ACRES IMPROVED

- Fence and water developments
  - Fence
    - Cross Fence – 239,507 feet
    - Boundary Fence – 54,975 feet
  - Water developments
    - Wetland Creations – 3
    - Wetland Enhancements – 3
    - Dugouts – 4
    - Water Tanks – 47
    - Water Pipeline – 70,754
- Approved grazing system on file to receive cost-share



# AG ENERGY PROJECTS

- Combination of all practices can be utilized
  - Invasive Tree removal
  - Saline soil remediation (non-legacy sites)
- Land reclamation on private lands where there is no responsible party
- Associated with Energy Development
